

Transportation Industry Bowl-a-Thon in aid of the Montreal Children's Hospital

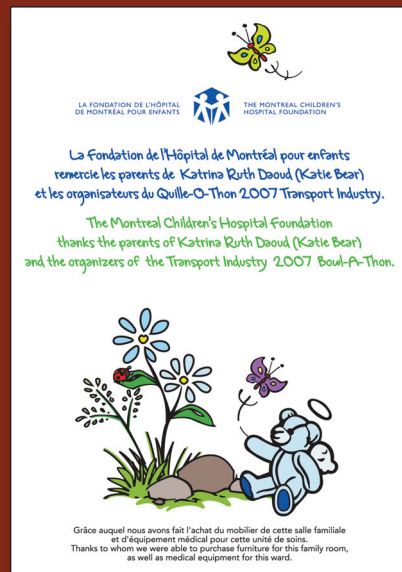
